



## Norms for Postulation of articles of Estudios Magazine

## **Definition of Estudios Magazine**

Estudios Magazine is a publication that develops in the History and Culture section of the General Studies school of the University of Costa Rica and its dedicated to reflect around history, communication, language, philosophy, art and every theme relevant to humanism.

## The articles presented to Revista Estudios must comply with the following norms:

- 1. Present articles that refer to the mentioned themes.
- 2. Only articles in two modalities will be received.

  - Sent by the online portal of magazines of the University of Costa Rica, subscription is free through this address:

- 3. The articles must be original, they must not be published in repositories, websites or blogs. They cannot be postulated at the same time in another magazine.
- 4. All articles must come with the letter of acceptance of copyright that can be sent scanned as a document by email or by the Magazine Portal of the University of Costa Rica. - 5. Its necessary to attach a short curriculum of no mor than 200 words of the author pointing out academic degrees, specialty, place of work, areas in which he develops and positions, email and telephone.

- 6. The articles are received in the following languages: Spanish, English, French, Italian and Portuguese. if you would like to propose another language ask through the email of the magazine.
- 7. Articles must be sent in Word format.
- 8. Use the normal margins: top and bottom 2,5 cm. Left and right 3 cm.
- 9. The maximum length of the articles is around 7 thousand words or 25 sheets of letter sized document. If the articles is bigger it can be studied for its publication.
- 10. The font is Arial 12 and space and a half (1.5).
- 11. The articles must have the following parts:
  - a) Títle: clear and concise.
  - **b) Author**: put the complete name without academic degrees, university or institution of work and country of the previous and an email.
  - c) Summary: In one paragraph of less than 150 words, the objetive of the article and its conclusions must be point out. It should be in spanish or the native language. It must be concise and explanatory,
  - **d) Key words:** 5-7 key words separated by semicolon
  - e) Title: In English
  - f) Abstract: In one paragraph of less than 150 words, the objetive of the article and its conclusions must be point out in English or a second language. it must coincide exactly with the article in the native language
  - g) Keywords: 5-7 key words in english or a second language separated by semicolon
- 12. Do not use footer notes instead add a final page titled notes.
- 13. Las imágenes y tablas deben ir en el documento de manera enumerada. Sin embargo, se recomienda adjuntarlas también en otro documento adjunto en formato Word como respaldo. The images and tables must be in the document numbered. It is recommended to attach them in another document in Word format as a backup.

- 14. The bibliography must be in alphabetical order with the APA model that can be consulted through the following link: https://revistas.ucr.ac.cr/public/journals/21/documentos/Estilo-de-la-APA-2017.pdf
- 15. All references should be in APA. In articles specialized in History the Chicago model may be used.
- 16. In case of plagirism the article will be rejected. in cases were the Normative of the system of plagirism detention is contemplated the author will be notified so that the necessary changes are made. - 17. Before the article is sent for revision in pairs an ad portas revision will be made to ensure in complies with the minimum requisites presented in this document. The editors would inform is changes should be made to the article or if it is rejected.
- **18.** Elements taken into account by the editorial committee to continue with the process of revision by pairs are :
  - a) If the work fill expectations for its academic content.
  - b) What new input or thesis it brings about the topic.
  - c) That it has a good theoretical and investigation backup.
  - d) That a good use of language is demonstrated in the article, expositive clarity and correct organisation of ideas.
- 19.
